A lovely example of the highly sought after Steve Hudson narrowboat with the iconic JP3 Lister engine that has had 2 owners from build. Set up as a spacious liveaboard, these boats are beautiful to handle and make for both an excellent home and/or extensive cruising of the network.

This particular boat is competitively priced for a quick sale, the price reflecting its use as a liveaboard and therefore the need to smarten it up in places.

Cabin space is maximised by substituting the traditional boatman's cabin for a master bedroom that includes a small nod to boatman's cabin features, with small stove and side bench. Other features include an iconic engine room, spacious walk-through bathroom, open plan saloon and galley that links to the front door.

Individual Rooms (From Fore to Aft)

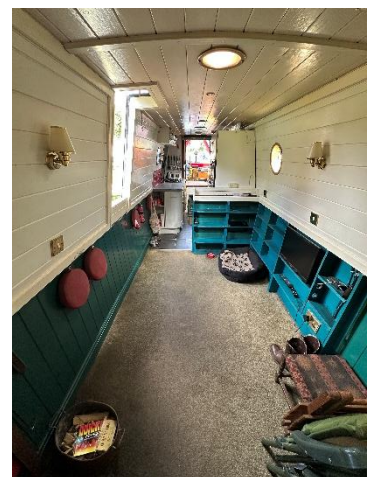
Galley:

- Passage style with melamine worktops in ash finish and tiled uplifts in poppy red
- Appliances and storage area concealed behind curtained fronts to give rustic look
- Shaker units in bold white with feature handles offer a range of storage solutions and are supplemented by upper open shelving
- High level oven and separate grill finished in black
- 4 burner LPG hob
- Feature matching sink and drainer with mixer tap
- 12v Domestic worktop height fridge with integral ice box (Note: One of the hinges is broken on this)





Saloon:



- Large open plan area for adding free standing furniture
- Plenty of room to have fitted furniture such as a L shape dinette added
- Lots of lower shelving that includes integral flat screen TV, very useful if being used for extensive cruising or liveaboard
- Morso Squirrel stove set on tiled hearth
- 2 Side hatches with swan drop in's



Bathroom:

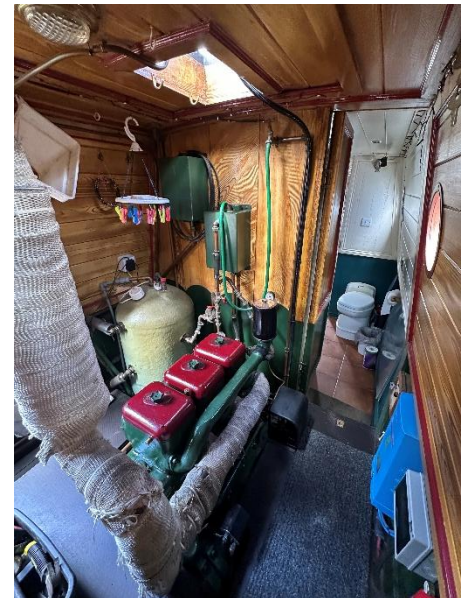
- Large walk through
- Hip bath with overhead shower
- Feature corner vanity with inset sink and cabinet to the side with mirror doors
- Decorative hanging shelf with shaving/make up mirror to the side
- Cassette toilet with spare cassette
- Full length hanging mirror on the back of the entry door

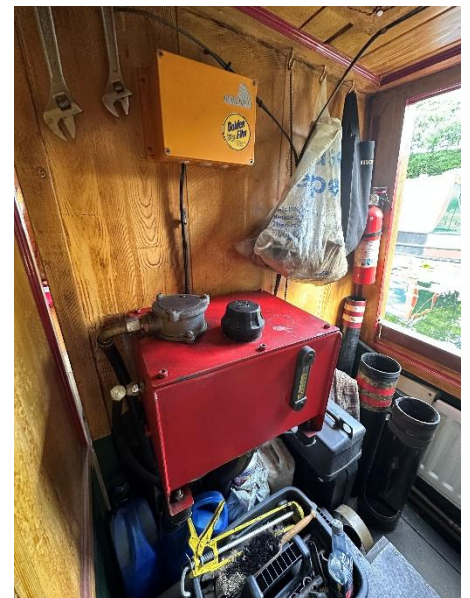




Engine Room:

- Large engine room to both showcase the engine and give all round access for easy maintenance
- Also houses electrics
- Plenty of space for additional storage
- 2 side hatches

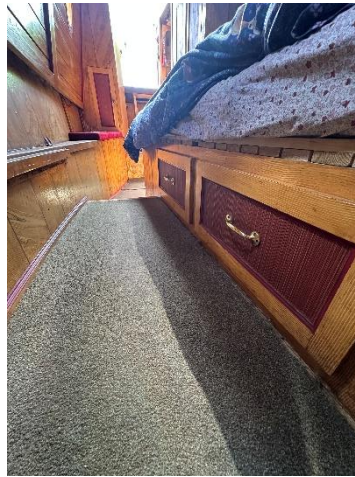




Bedroom

- Combined bedroom and mini boatman's cabin
- Cupboards have feature insets in wine grained look finish
- Storage below the bed and hanging cupboards above and to the side
- Large wardrobe at the base with small bench seat opposite
- Boatman stove on the portside as you enter from the rear counter
- Further cupboard and shelf storage with decorative scroll work finish

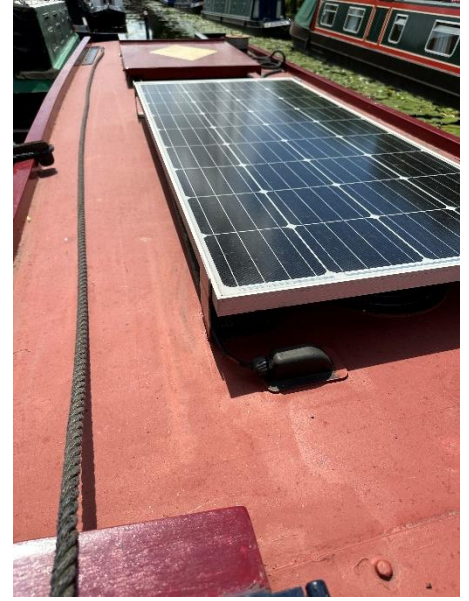
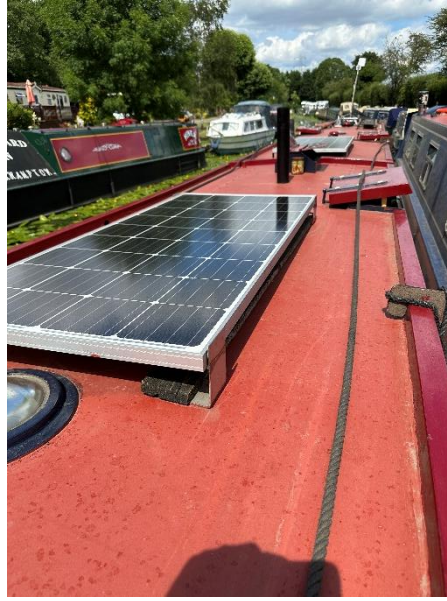




External

- Canvas cover and glazed cratch on the front deck making this a great place for alfresco dining/relaxing after a hard day at work or cruising

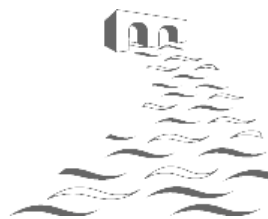


Other

- **Documentation:**
RCD: Built prior to RCD
Builders Certificate of Conformity: No
Other: Original invoices from builder. Bills of Sale for previous and current owners. Folder detailing receipts and paperwork including manuals and instructions
- As this is an older boat then it is probable that the height of through hull fittings above the water line will be less than the minimum 250mm recommended by surveyors
- Electrical installations with older boats were satisfactory at the time of fitting but are often outdated and sometimes surveyors recommend upgrading to meet current requirements
